<b>Name of proposal</b>	Alternative ways for conflict resolution in police contexts
<b>Summary of the proposal</b>	<p>The “<b>Policia Local de Castellón</b>” (<b>PLCS</b>) is a department of the Castellón City Council, in the region of Valencia (Spain), which has within its main competences the security of the city, but also it may provide the assistance in conflict mediation and resolution.</p> <p>The PLCS has a unit of Quality for improving the processes, the development of contents, and the methodology of work in all the departments. And one of these departments is the unit of Proximity Police, directly involved in the present project, that aims to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Research and compare the different methodologies on conflict solution that are being used by the police forces in different parts of the European Union, in order to elaborate a protocol based on how to deal with citizens conflicts avoiding the escalation of it.</li> </ul> <p>The specific objectives of the project will be to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Establish the main skills needed for conflict solution, in order to empower policemen with these skills.</li> <li>• Apply the Directive 2008/52/CE of the European Parliament and the Council of May the 21st of 2008, regarding the friendly mediation in civil and mercantile conflicts.</li> <li>• Establish an online consultative system and network for solving conflicts.</li> <li>• Elaborate and establish statistical indicators for practices, functioning and outcomes of conflict solutions in the European Union.</li> </ul> <p>That is the reason why we are interested in carry out a Leonardo Project of Development of Innovation, and for that reason we are looking for partners inside the police system (police units/ teams, etc.) from EU countries which would host our professionals on active service with an executive/ technical or higher position inside our police units.</p>
